Dear National JSHS student delegate:

On behalf of the Academy of Applied Science and the United States Departments of the Army, Navy, and Air Force, we wish to congratulate your outstanding academic achievement! In recognition of your achievement in conducting an original research investigation, we are pleased to invite you to attend the 48th National Junior Science and Humanities Symposium (JSHS), April 28 – May 2, 2010 in Bethesda, Maryland.

The 48th National JSHS will bring together 240 high school students who qualify for attendance through paper competitions held at 48 nationwide JSHS regional symposia. Adult leaders—high school teachers, university faculty, ranking military guests, and others—attend and join in encouraging the future generation of scientists and engineers and celebrating student achievement in the sciences.

A full program will be planned in cooperation with our hosts -- the Army Research Laboratory, Adelphi, Maryland, and the U.S. Army Research Office, Research Triangle Park, N.C. Visit <http://www.jshs.org> for program highlights and scheduled activities.

To register for the 48th National, please visit <http://www.jshs.org>, "National symposium section," and access registration forms at the "Student" section. Your pre-registration will first be completed by the JSHS regional symposium director. You may access this pre-registration by entering your social security number; then, please enter registration data, including personal choices for tours, hotel reservations, and meal choices. Early registration is March 20; late registration is April 3.

Attached for your convenience are registration instructions, and the "National JSHS Consent form." **Each student** should prepare and submit:

- 1) a 200-word abstract for publication in the conference program (electronic submission required);
- 2) the National JSHS consent form, requiring your signature and the signature of your parent/guardian (submitted in paper form);
- 3) for paper presenters only--a research paper and statement on outside assistance (electronic submission required).

Before submitting your registration, please decide on your commitment to attend and participate. Airline tickets purchased by the National JSHS are non-refundable, penalty tickets. Any changes or cancellation after the ticket is issued result in a loss to the National JSHS Program and take away the opportunity for other students who may wish to attend.

Your airline ticket and final details for your participation in the 48th National will be forwarded to you after the registration deadline. Registration packets, name badges, and tour schedules will be distributed at the symposium.

Upon receiving your request for room reservations, the National JSHS Office will reserve hotel accommodations at the Bethesda North Marriott, 5701 Marinelli Rd., Bethesda, Maryland 20852; Tel. 301-822-9200. Three students may be assigned to a room to accommodate the large number of participants.

The program dress is comfortable and casual. For the paper sessions, attendees typically dress more professionally. The dress for the banquet and awards ceremony is semi-formal. For all other symposium activities, you're welcome to wear slacks, jeans, shorts, tennis shoes -- whatever makes you feel comfortable and eager to learn and participate. (Participants should plan to wear closed-toe shoes for any off-site tours.)
